Present: Paul, Wybren, Bob, Aard, Mark, Des, Marjolein

MT meeting tomorrow, so send in items if needed.

Wybren: database migration db0=>db-1-but-then-new-0 (or so) ongoing. Mounted HDDs in sfxc-i nodes, not enough 4TB disks for -j nodes; after enough data moved can move HDDs to -j nodes. Preparing a new Ansible VM. Enabling monitoring on cl[23]: repeated warnings about one (1) file that needs healing, suspicious: looks like file does not exist, will discuss w/ Paul before disabling/ignoring; auto-discovery sadly doesn't work. New "northstar-ng" VM in preparation.

Bob: working on pySCHED catalog updates for Session I/2025, merge ongoing w/ some build problems – seems related to local conda install. MartinL moving data into fb19 ("pre-loading"): updated vex2db to support > 1 exp on cmd line. Re new "northstar-ng" VM: db will remain self-hosted, old Java can't talk to new db engine(s). Revisited Observatory Control System – expected to give talk last week but due to mail delivery issues announcement to LCO staff did not happen: postponed into early March.

Des: Northstar view successfully federated into db0. Working on PapersDB: one query suddenly slow: fixed; will put into (parallel) production tomorrow. An "almost" machine readable vsn of the block schedule already exists: following that one up – other meta data sourced from other sources anyway; working w/ BenitoM on this, run by EVN Scheduler if a prototype is available. CASA fringeFIT SPW slicing/dicing: needs to get into next vsn of CASA; EHT scientists have signed off, now need to define tests in CASA6.

Aard: axis flipping in SFXC (reported by Ventspils colleagues): installed newer vsn of j2ms2, problem gone (were using ~2018 vsn). Wrote input for RADIOBLOCKS D4.4; JohnR's GPU filter: now does reals (yay) but only fp16 (less yay) but sais can make fp32 avail [MarkK: could do kernel in fp16] A: Yes; would allow direct comparison. SFXC paper: will be accepted after minor revision. Finding out several broken/usability issues w/ JupyterHub: exps missing from notebook db and V0-query a bit broken, and some plugin GUI issues; this Thu will have online presentation at ACME workshop.

Mark: after finding out jplotter documentation not 100% correct was able to demonstrate that BeamWaveGuide corrections in CASA work: approved PR but need to check with TammoJD before merge. Had VLBI coord mtng last week; NRAO access not yet working for me (ok for Des); new CASA project lead: UrvashiR working on other topic(s) – if invited to VLBI coord mtng will let @Marjo know to get acquainted; casacore: tests for FITS-IDI written, almost ready to submit. EHT tiger team formed: current PolConvert usage method results in some ALMA data issues, looking into other options and YT asked to share insights. Had several RADIOBLOCKS meetings; planning meeting mostly w/ ASTRON (IlseB, AndreG) looking for overlap; D4.4 text needs to be submitted this week. ParselTongue script to generate ampcal

statistics created, hand-over to Sup.Sci imminent.

Paul: requested access to proposal from db0, Q: working? [A: yes]. Discussion on EEE2 install w/ BenitoM/Jungwan0 [difference between casacore and CASA explained and why both need to be on the machine, but casacore not as package, want controlled environment for j2ms2/tConvert/jplotter]; use ticket #824 for collecting EEE2 requirements. Created ICT ticket for connection fb's to DAS6 [MarkK: checked w/ Steven vdV? May submit/have submitted similar ticket] A: ICT will merge, or not. h/w donated to 3fm serious request still not collected.

Marjolein: j2ms2 did not compile out of the box on new(er) O/S e.g. Ubuntu 24.04 LTS, now it does (on experimental branch) [Q: will be merged?] A: Yes, after at least minimal regression testing (not yet done).
