Paul: Attended EFTF – pretty good (see trip report). Onsala to 100Gbps, tested that they can still do e-VLBI. FITS-IDI question by Joel: answered. CopyFail CVE – lots of patches. Many systems patched by now, few remaining systems to patch. "Unfixable": Ubuntu 22, 18; no upgrade, can get paid service. some systems need OS upgrade before can be fixed; Linux desktop → make sure patched! Workshop nfs + stats. Last Friday: close to going to ASTRON b/c temp warnings, got fixed by staff on site. No answer from NRAO re fw ruleset. evlbi.org was gone: turned out that IP addr in DNS was alias for another machine. sfxc-k3 did not come up after reboot (is fringetest machine) – will need fix.

Bob: db access to proposal from EEE fixed. POLARIS work: Institute uses ROR api, merged w/ manual edit. Modal windows close on token refresh, should get same state on refresh but doesn't look to be the case; maybe modal to non-modal seems to have no negative impact (i.e. hopefully fixed). Problem if create/delete spectral window: seems to be a timing window / UI inconsistency, now all "store on save": prob w/ hibernate: has internal "order" column, async update is cause for misordering. Might be fixable to make delete/edits synchronous. PySCHED bug: "nosetup" gives error – sumfile infers Tsys file (eg in freq catalog): fixed. BobC: setups for next session, put freq entries in catalogs.

Des: presented proposal for MSv4 calibration table format, need data to demonstrate. Michael]: new casa bug, reported several times w/o example ("won't fix" without test case)– but Michael] created one.

Marjolein: mailing list software swapped, turned out none of the "jive.eu" mailing lists worked. Fortunately we found out within a few hours and ASTRON ICT fixed it.
